It is famously said that Chianti is bottled poetry, and you can indulge directly at the Viticcio Winery Estate and the Casa del Chianti Classico for a tasting. Keep driving east and across the beautiful Monastery & Olive Oil facility at Badia Coltbuono for lunch and olive oil tasting at the old monastery. Post lunch, drive further south to reach the medieval Brolio Castle, ancestral home to the Ricasoli family, founding fathers of the Chianti wine and learn all about their interesting history.





# Day 4

## Drive 3 - Borderlands of Florence & Route Mille Miglia

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The drive today will be more relaxed as you will be exploring some beautiful hilltop towns through Tuscan hills west of Florence. First on the list is Monteriggioni, a small walled town known for its well-preserved medieval walls and 14 towers that encircle the town providing panoramic views of the surrounding countryside. Next up is San Gimignano, often called the Town of Fine Towers because of 14 stand-alone towers forming a unique skyline that dominates the town. As you stop for lunch, savour the Tuscan cuisine, and inhale the flavours of the countryside which utilizes ingredients such as olive oil, fresh herbs, basil, beans, vegetables, bread, and high-quality meats. Post your leisurely meal hop back into the car to drive the famous Mille Miglia race route again. Finally, celebrate your passion for driving as you test your supercar on the SP222 (Strada Chiantigiana), the most scenic road in Tuscany. A final stop of the day is made in the village of Greve in Chianti, for an afternoon coffee and cakes. The tour then finishes in the hills near Florence at your luxury hotel.





**1. What if there is damage to the car, how much does insurance cover ?**

The insurance excess depends upon your choice of vehicle. Once we know which car you prefer to drive, we will send you all details about the insurance excess and how to pay for it.

**2. Does the cost we pay include our insurance premium charges?**

Yes, the package cost includes vehicle insurance premium but it does not include the insurance excess amount i.e. the maximum amount you will have to pay in the event of any damage to the vehicle.

**3. I have an Indian license, do I need an International Drivers Permit, will AO Help me with this.**

Your Indian driver's license allows you to drive in Europe as a tourist.

**4. Should I get an Indian service operator package for my mobile or get a local SIM?**

Normally, your Indian service operator will give you the option of an international roaming package which is the most convenient option. However, in case you require a local SIM, our team can help you in facilitating for the same.

**5. For small issues like the tyre gets punctured or the vehicle breakdown, will I get roadside assistance?**

Yes, vehicle breakdown assistance is included in the package.

**6. How many Kilometres will I be driving in a day ?**

You will be driving 250-280 Kilometres on an average everyday.

**7. How much driving experience do I need to do this drive?**

Drivers must be a minimum of 25 years old. We expect you to be a confident and competent driver, with plenty of driving experience. You should normally have held your driver's license for a minimum of five years and have some experience of driving in a foreign country.

**8. Will my luggage fit in the Car**

Due to limited luggage space in the majority of these cars, we suggest opting for medium-sized soft luggage that can be easily accommodated. In most cases, where the journey starts and ends at the same location, we can assist you in storing any additional luggage at the hotel, allowing you to retrieve it after your tour. For precise details regarding luggage capacity, we can furnish you with more specific information based on the car you select.

**9. What kind of people travel on such drives?**
