India & Nepal

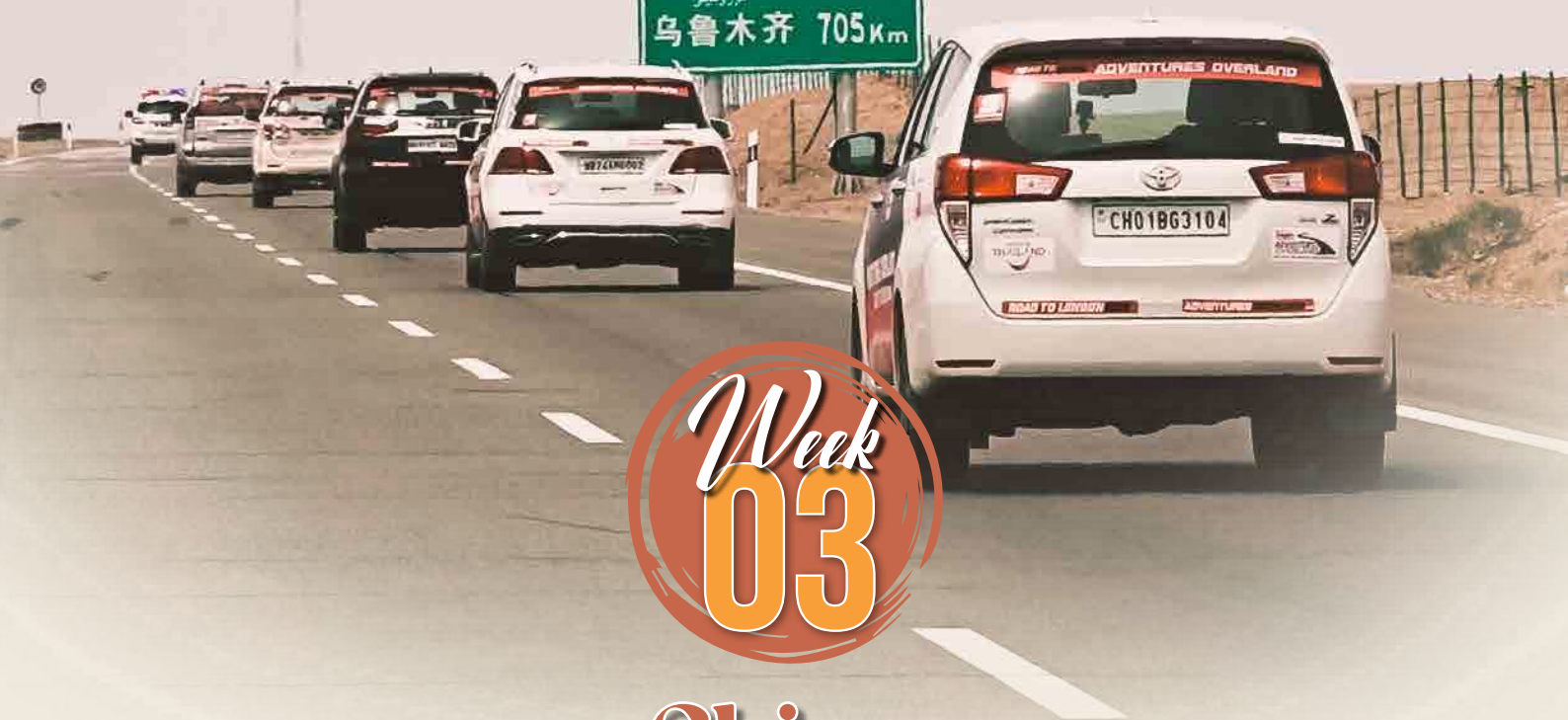
Our group assembles in the North Indian city of Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh. Meet and greet the organising team, as well as the fellow roadtrippers who will be your pals in all things fun and trying for the next two months. From here, our cavalcade will cross the border into the Himalayan abode of Nepal at the town of Bharatpur. The next destination on our route is the Nepalese capital of Kathmandu - one of the Oldest Continuously Inhabited Places in the World which boasts temples and palaces galore - where we will spend the rest of the week exploring and luxuriating while completing visa formalities.



China

The second week of this incredible adventure dawns in Kathmandu, which we bid adieu to the following day to cross the border into the picturesque wonder that's Tibet. Let the crisp mountain air wash over you, as you meander through the stunningly quaint towns of Nyalam and Tingri. Enroute to Tingri - prepare to be humbled by the colossal magnificence of the Himalayas, as we visit the Everest Base Camp. Crossing the cities of Shigatse, where we also acquire the requisite driving licences and plates, our merry troupe finally zooms towards the Tibetan capital of Lhasa. On the road to Lhasa, pay your respects at the Tashi Lhunpo Monastery which was founded by the first Dalai Lama.

Perched high amidst the mountains, and the nerve-centre of the Tibetan Buddhist world, Lhasa is a treat for the senses. Revel in the towering grace of Potala Palace - a World Heritage Site, which soars over 380 ft above the Red Hill. Let the spiritual essence of Jokhang Temple overwhelm your senses, as you pay obeisance at this World Heritage Site which comes surrounded by a vibrant, one-way praying route known as Barkhor Street. Gaze in awe upon the towering Mount Everest, sip upon a piping-hot brew, soak-in the spiritual serenity of Tibet, click amazing pictures, and create memories to last a lifetime!



China

The third week of this sojourn dawns with our enthused drivers getting ready to take the wheel, and master the rugged mountain terrain as we head towards the Tibetan county of Damxung. Enroute to Damxung, our motorcade will make a stop at the shimmering Namtso (also known as Lake Nam). Explore the sprawling and biologically diverse Qiangtang Grasslands (home to the famous Wild Yak), as we cruise onwards to Amdo. The next destination on our route is the city of Golmud, via the exemplary Kekexili Nature Reserve, which offers you the chance to experience uninhibited wildlife.

The second half of the week begins with our arrival into the city of Dunhuang in Gansu, Western China. Enroute, feast your eyes upon the majestic Kunlun Mountains, and the mystifying salt plains of Qarhan. A sight which can only be believed upon being seen, the Qarhan Playa is a treasure trove of valuable salt, mineral, and rare earth reserves. Once in Dunhuang, be wowed by the stark splendour of the Gobi Desert, followed by an entertaining evening that will cap-off the day perfectly. The following day will have us visiting the World Heritage Site of Mogao Caves which comprises a network of 500 temples featuring majestic Buddhist art. The last day of this week will see our band of explorers leaving for Turpan in Xinjiang. This region of China is notable for sharing a border with eight countries - Mongolia, Russia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Afghanistan, Pakistan, as well as India.



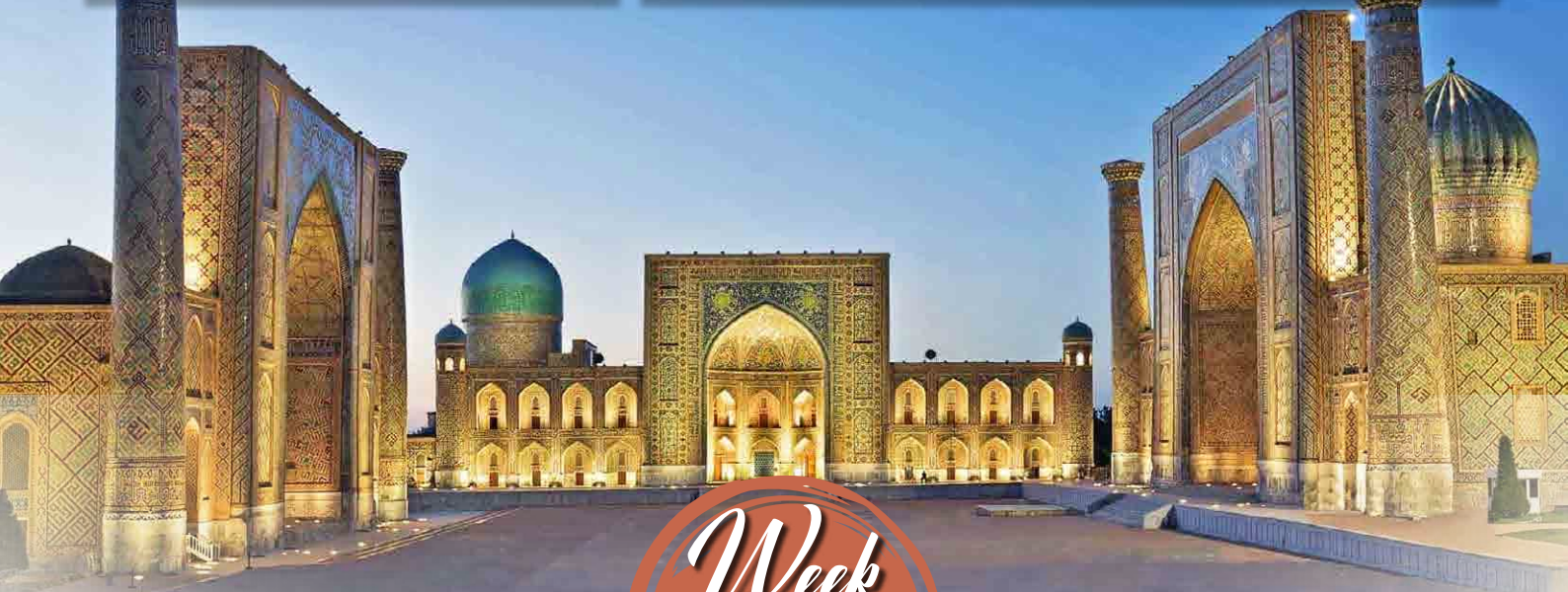
China & Kyrgyzstan

We roll into the fourth week of this life-altering journey with a farewell to Turpan, as we head towards the second largest city in the Xinjiang region, Kuerle. A restful night later, our group of adrenaline-seekers once again take to the road in their sturdy SUVs to arrive at the next destination - the city of Aksu on the edge of the Tarim Basin. Enjoy the verdant freshness of the Populus Forest Park, one of the most famous tourist attractions in the city. You will also get a chance to flex your driving skills as you zoom through the remarkable Tarim Desert Expressway, which cuts across the Taklamakan Desert.

Aksu will be followed on the route by one of the Oldest Continuously Inhabited Places in the World, Kashgar. Stroll through winding alleyways of the Old Town, as you sneak a peek at vintage houses and engraved gates while savouring some delightful local flavours.

Having enjoyed a generous helping of Chinese culture, we are now set to enter the realm of the 'Stan' countries. The week continues with our buoyant bunch taking to the historic and incredibly challenging Pamir Glacier Highway, which stands surrounded by the looming Pamir Mountains (aka 'Roof of the World') on all sides. Prepare to push yourself to the extremes as you manoeuvre painstakingly through this iconic route, which has been in use for over 2000 years.

Crossing yet another border, we will now reach the Silk Road-era city of Osh in Kyrgyzstan. Along with being a long-established centre for trade in the area, Osh also hosts an expansive bazaar which is located along the Ak-Bura River. While here, pay a visit to the only World Heritage Site in the country – Sulaiman Too. The final day of week four will dawn with us bidding adieu to Kyrgyzstan, and crossing the border to head towards the garden city of Fergana in Uzbekistan.

Uzbekistan

This week is all about discovering the verve and charm of the country that can be aptly described as Central Asia's biggest draw - Uzbekistan. With Fergana whizzing past in the rearview mirror, our SUVs eat up the miles as we head towards the gorgeous capital city of Tashkent. Meander through the lively chaos at Chorsu Bazaar; revel in the vintage vibe of the Museum of Applied Arts; and seek blessings for your loved ones at the pristinely stunning Minor Mosque.

Next up on the road ahead stands one of the most impressive and gorgeous cities that marked the bygone Silk Road - Samarkand. The veritable jewel of Uzbekistan, this spectacular city will leave you spellbound with its attractions like the Registan Square which comes framed on three sides by marvellous madrassas. The other must-visit destination here is the Gur-e-Amir Mausoleum. Intricately detailed and shimmering in varied shades of blue, Gur-e-Amir serves as the final resting place of Turco mongol conqueror, Timur.

The penultimate city on this leg of our excursion is the mesmerising Bukhara. Enjoy the structural brilliance of the oldest existing funerary building of Central Asian Islamic Architecture, the Tomb of Ismail Samanid. Soak-in the views of the historic Ark of Bukhara - a rambling fortress of immense stature. Step back in time with a visit to the Chor Minor; an iconic gatehouse which forms one part of the World Heritage Site Historic Centre of Bukhara. Having experienced and captured in snapshots the very best the region has to offer, the week concludes with our terrific troupe cruising onwards from Bukhara to the city of Khiva.



Kazakhstan & Russia

We are now into week six of this incomparable road adventure. We have explored and wandered; we have been awed and enthralled; we have captured countless memories and experienced cultures and peoples galore. To be succinct, we have been having the time of our lives!

Bidding farewell to Uzbekistan, we leave Nukus to cross the border into Kazakhstan at the city of Beyneu. Next day we make our way to the transcontinental city of Atyrau. Feast your gaze upon gorgeous seascapes and indulge in photo-ops, as we make a pit-stop close to the Caspian Sea. You get a full day to rest, recuperate and roam the lanes of Atyrau.

The second half of the week will witness our cavalcade crossing yet another border. We exit the captivating Kazakhstan to enter the world's biggest country, Russia. Our advent into this transcontinental nation begins with the city of Astrakhan, which sits pretty on two banks of the mighty Volga River. Dig into some scrumptious local fare and observe the pace of life here, as you wander through the streets of this southernmost outpost of Russia. Week six finally draws to a close with our arrival at Budënnovsk - a mid-size town in Stavropol Krai of Russia.



Russia & Georgia

A new week is here, ripe with the promise of exploration, revelation and adventure! We launch into the seventh week of our sojourn with an exciting drive from Budënnovska towards the picturesque city of Nalchik which sits at an elevation of 1800 ft, on the foothills of Caucasus Mountains. Enroute to Nalchik, prepare to be wonderstruck by the sight of the highest peak in Russia and Europe. Mount Elbrus is a dormant volcano which rises approximately 18,510 ft above sea level. Following Nalchik, we will arrive in the lush green village of Verkhniy Fiagdon in North Ossetia-Alania to spend a night of tranquillity and peace.

Prepare to cross the border into the country of Georgia, as we wave a heartfelt goodbye to Russia and enter the Georgian capital city of Tbilisi. A truly cosmopolitan city set in a postcard-pretty valley, Tbilisi has at its heart the Old Town which hosts some of its most historic attractions. Next up on our schedule is the Georgian port city of Batumi. Superbly distinctive architecture and sculptural beauty add to the allure of this gorgeous seaside destination, which is also known as the 'Las Vegas of the Black Sea'. We conclude this leg of our road trip par excellence by exiting Georgia, and making entryway into the ever-fascinating Turkey.

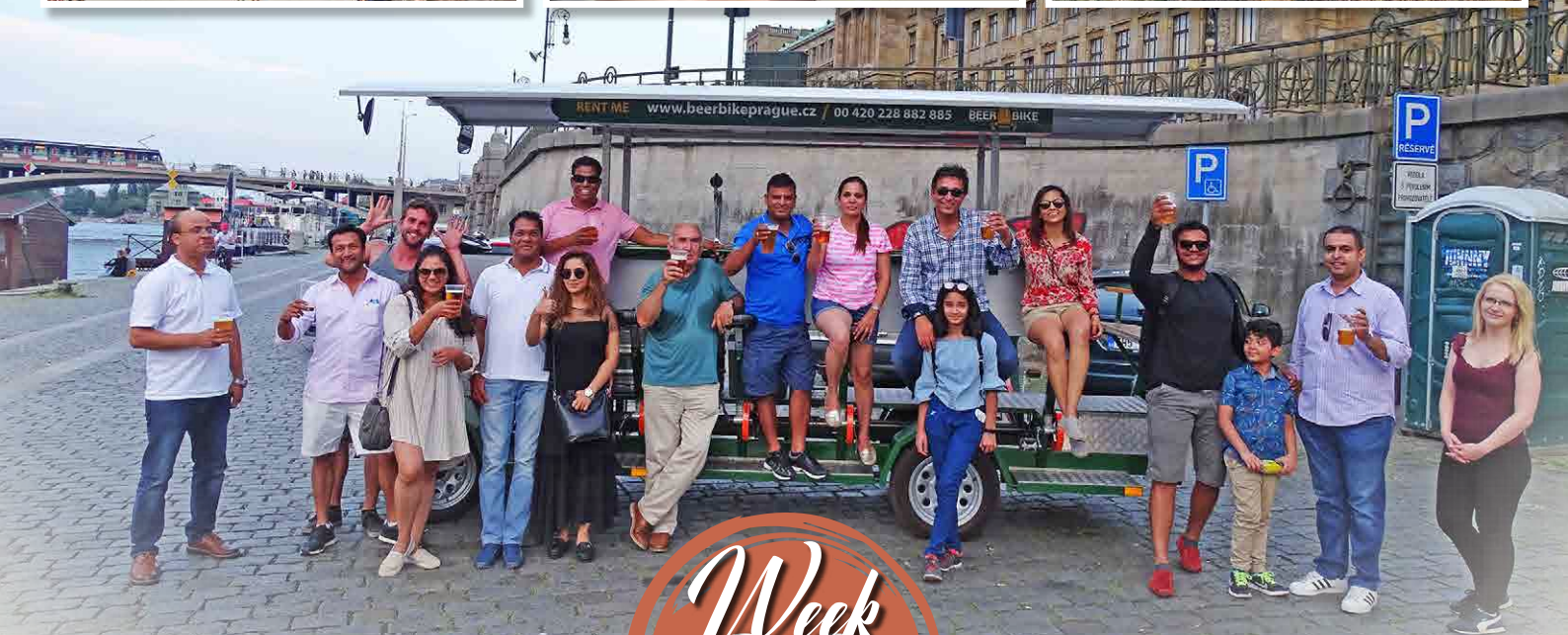
Turkey, Greece, Bulgaria & Serbia

The week begins in Trabzon - a city on the Black Sea coast of northeastern Turkey - from where we will head towards the city of natural wonders Cappadocia, an ancient district in East-Central Anatolia, situated on the rugged plateau north of the Taurus Mountains. Next day we will experience a Hot Air Balloon Ride at sunrise which is definitely the best and most amazing way to see the incredible Cappadocia landscape. Later in the day we will visit the Devrent Valley known as Imagination Valley with spectacular fairy chimneys and beautiful landscapes.

Post Cappadocia, our group of adventurers will leave for the capital city of Istanbul. Urbane, yet infused with an infectious vintage feel, Istanbul is sure to leave an indelible impression upon you. A tour of this magical city, along with a luxurious cruise upon the strait of Bosphorus will bring our Turkish endeavour to a splendid close.

Mid-week sees us crossing the border from Turkey into Greece and then to the capital of Bulgaria, Sofia. We get a full day to decipher the best-kept secrets of this wonderfully varied city, which has a distinctive relaxed vibe to it. Following Sofia, our convoy will cross the border into Belgrade, Serbia. A dream destination for history and antiquity enthusiasts, the capital of Serbia is one of the Oldest Continuously Inhabited Cities in the World. Take in the sights of this classical city, as you sit back and enjoy a cruise upon the second longest river in Europe, the Danube.

With so much to see, relish and celebrate - this incredible experience is sure to have left you happily high on life by now!



Hungary, Austria, Slovakia, Czech Republic, Germany & Belgium

It's time to take the wheel again and add to those climbing numbers on the odometer. The ninth week of our excursion begins with us exiting Belgrade to crossover into the capital of Hungary, Budapest. The financial and artistic nerve centre of Hungary, Budapest is cosmopolitan, suave, culturally and architecturally blessed and home to an abundance of natural hot springs.

Post Prague, our fleet of road beasts is ready to cross into the country of Belgium at the capital city of Brussels. 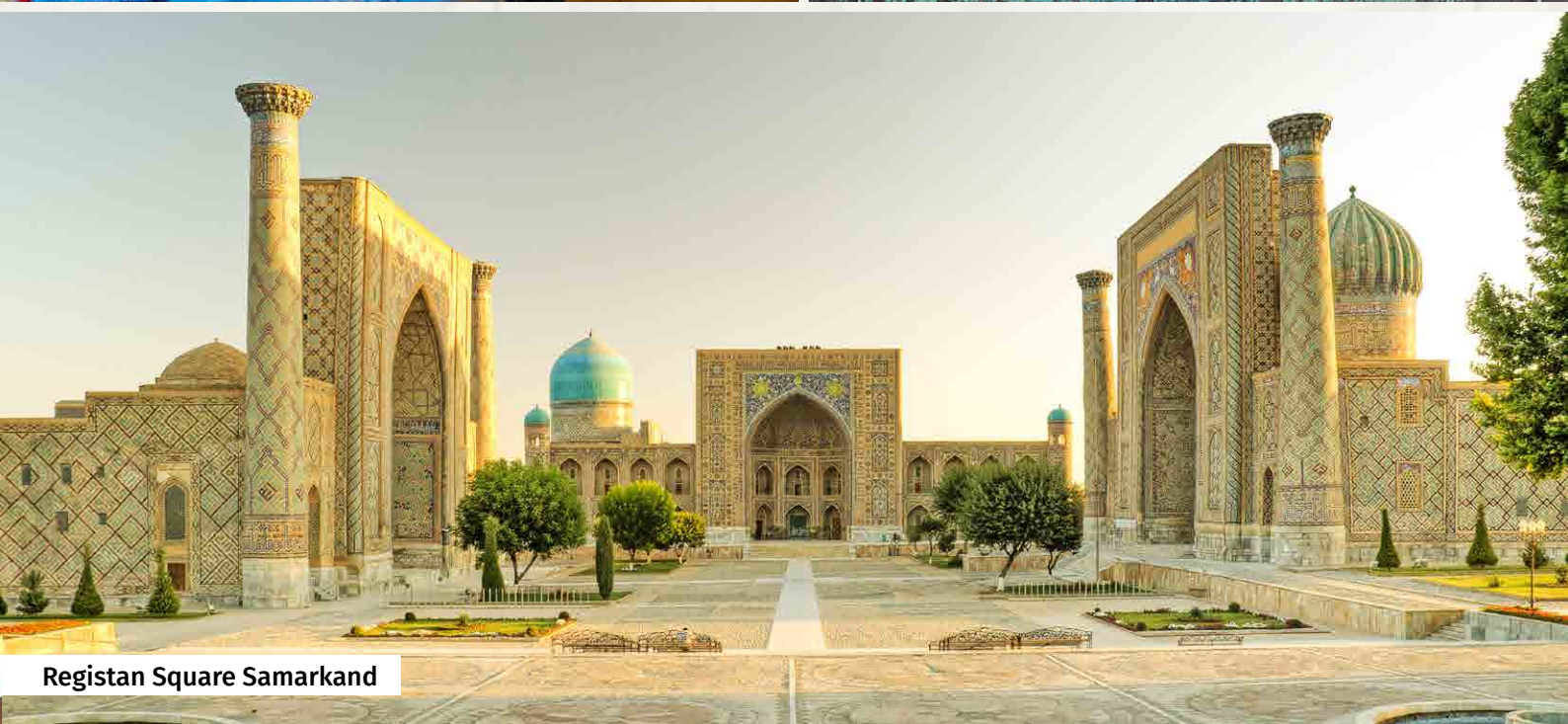

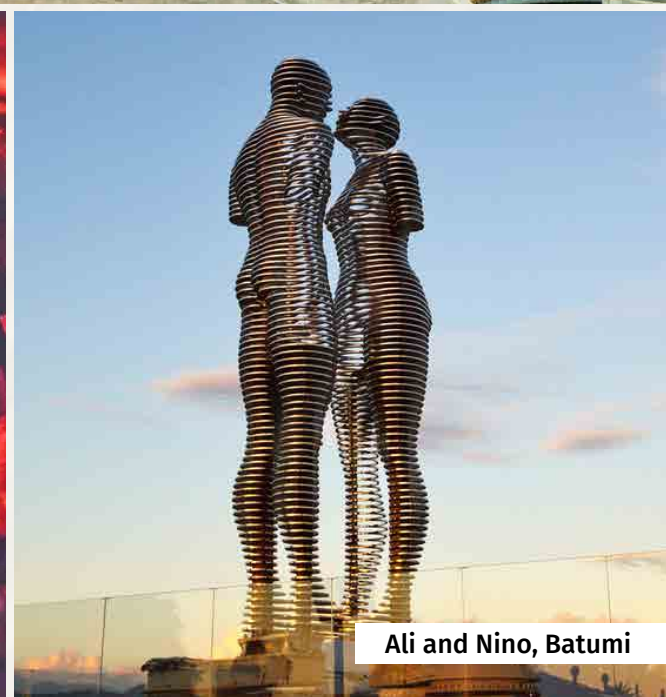

What to expect on Road to London?

After successfully organising and leading various cross border expeditions, here are some points from our experience that are worth mentioning, so you come not just packed but also prepared for this rewarding and life-changing journey.



Food: We believe that cooking and eating in a foreign country is the surest and truest way to experience a country. That's why we make the best possible arrangements for you to sample the best of local delicacies and regional dishes that will leave your taste buds forever in debt! Also, we carry an emergency stash of packing Indian food for the days when you miss and crave our good old Indian food. Please also consider that there will be some days when the food options will be limited and you may not get the best choices of food items that you are used to, those are the days when your understanding would be highly appreciated.



Border Crossings: Road to London is a cross border expedition, which means that you will be crossing through multiple borders during the journey. Passing through land borders is a completely different experience compared to airports. Border crossings can be unpredictable and extremely slow. Although we make all the necessary arrangements beforehand to make the border-crossing process smooth and quick, you may still have to wait for many hours at certain borders. Patience will be a massive virtue at the borders!



Accommodations: At the end of a long-distance driving day, we understand the sheer importance of a warm and comfortable stay for you to kick your legs up and relax. That's why we have carefully picked the best hotels and resorts throughout the journey.



What to expect on Road to London?



Long-driving Days and Early Starts: No distance feels long in good company. Every single driving day has been planned after carefully analysing and researching on the road conditions and facilities en route. There will be days when you will have to wake up very early and drive all day long before reaching the destination. On some days, even though the distance may not look too long but you will have to make an early start as we may have many sightseeing activities planned during the day. Trust us, once you reach London, you won't even remember the time when you had to leave your cosy bed a little early, but you will undoubtedly cherish the tiring days on the road.



Planned Sightseeing: It is always the unplanned things that you remember rather than the planned ones! Despite the best of planning and efforts, there's still the possibility of a few hiccups along the way – breakdowns, bad weather, border issues etc. don't come announced and these can cause delays which may force us to skip some planned activities.



Rest Days: The motto for rest days is "Your Day, Your Way". We may have planned some sightseeing or walking tours but you can enjoy complete freedom to plan your day as per your interest. So, go ahead and catch up on sleep or shop to your heart's desire or just tick off all the local sights... the choice is yours. If you need any help to plan your day, feel free to knock on the door of your tour coordinator's room for assistance.



Route Planning: It is fascinating to be out on the road and even more exciting to take pit-stops and detours! But the route for Road to London has been carefully planned by professionals to ensure that you have the best experience, without compromising on your safety and comfort. Our task is to make you reach London by road...safely and on time! We have to obtain special overland driving permits, and permissions from government bodies in many countries and some countries don't permit us to divert from the designated route. All cars will have to continue driving on the predetermined route throughout the journey.



Useful information/FAQS

Is the above schedule fixed? We like to stick to the designed schedule as much as possible. But, all participants must be prepared for changes in route due to uncertain weather conditions, road blockages and any other probabilities.

What kind of Vehicle will I need? We recommend SUV Vehicles as some terrains may have gravel & dirt roads, high altitudes and steep climbing. Such a vehicle will withstand all terrains and give you a comfortable driving experience as well.

Can we take our own car or will you arrange one for us? You have both options available. All vehicles will need paperwork like Carnet de Passage, which is like a passport for your car. We will assist in procuring the same whether the vehicle is owned by you or rented from us.

Will vegetarian meals be an issue? Most regions offer vegetarian food, though it may not be lavish. We will also be carrying some ready to eat meal options with us in case of emergencies.

What about medical assistance in case of any emergency? Our crew vehicle will be equipped with first aid kits and basic medical supplies. You must carry any prescribed medications that you take with you in abundance, as those may not be readily available in these countries.

Will you help us procure all documents? Yes, we will help you get all the relevant documents like Visa, Carnet de Passage, permits and permission needed for driving across multiple borders. You will also be briefed about rules and regulations applicable in all the countries we will cross.

What all documents will be needed? A detailed list will be mailed to you well in advance. We will assist you with each and every step with respect to procuring all the relevant documents both for you and the vehicle.

What driving experience do I need? As long as you have an International Driving Permit and are comfortable with driving, you are welcome to join the team. No particular driving experience across borders or hilly terrains will hinder you, as we will be there throughout to help and guide you. In case you aren't comfortable driving an SUV by yourself, you can still join this expedition. We will either club you with other participants or offer you a seat in our vehicle, to ensure that you have a comfortable journey.

What about vehicle breakdowns and other maintainance? Our crew will always be there to help you with breakdown and emergency situation.

Will fuel be readily available? Yes, fuel will be available throughout.

Visa and Passport requirement? We will be processing 10 visas for Indian passport holders to cover the entire journey. The participant must have passport validity until 31st December 2024 and 10 clean pages.

Vehicle Insurance? We will be taking third party Insurance for all the vehicles for all the countries we will be travelling through.

Shipment of Vehicle UK to India? We will assist with the shipment of vehicle from UK to India and its custom clearance in India. The shipment and custom clearance will take approx 45 days.
